~ Cemetery Rules ~

- Prohibited: flower picking (wild/cultivated), breaking or injuring trees, shrubs, plants, defacing in any way any memorial, fence or other structure.
- Maximum speed limit is 15 M.P.H.; no vehicle may be driven or parked across any grave, lot or lawn. No vehicle may block a drive or road.
- No domestic animals will be allowed outside vehicles.
- Placing boxes, shells, toys, ornaments, chairs, settees or similar unauthorized items upon lots is not encouraged.
- Firearms are prohibited except by military escort.
- To transfer/sell assigned lot, arrangements and agreement must be made with the Town Office.
- Unused assigned lots may be returned to the Town with no remuneration to the owner. The portion of perpetual care paid on unused lots will be returned to the owner when the lots are sold by the Town.
- Perpetual care covers continuous mowing and trimming for the life of the cemetery.
- No lot or grave shall be defined by a fence, rail, curb, hedge, tree or shrub for the purpose of describing its corners or boundaries.
- It shall be the responsibility of the lot owners or their representative to remove unsightly, passé floral displays/containers by October 15th.
- Willful violation of rules and regulations is subject to a fine of not more than \$25.00.
