Mark — this is a case we heard a year ago from Mister Calvin Brown who lost his structure to a fire. He sold the lot and this couple wishes to build a cottage on the old location.

Ed – it sounds like it's important to have erosion control measures in place.

Gary – will you be using the same footprint? Anneliese – it will be a little more centered in the lot.
