Town Re-opening Updates: Town Office and Library Services to Expand June 1

WINTHROP, Maine – Select services and departments will begin a gradual and measured re-opening based on state and CDC guidelines and the ability to follow best practices for social/physical distancing in specific locations. Because COVID-19 remains a threat, and in-person service is limited due to space requirements, we strongly encourage residents to continue to conduct town business online whenever possible.

Starting June 1, the Clerk’s office will open for limited in-person transactions. Business with Assessing, Codes Enforcement, General Assistance and the Town Manager should please make an appointment and/or call those offices upon arrival to meet in a conference room when available. Employees and customers must wear cloth masks when interacting with each other and queue at the indicated spacing, denoted on the floor/ground. Please be patient and follow the guidelines as given the small space, only 1-2 customers can be in the office at a time.

Also on June 1, The Bailey Public Library will begin lending items via curbside delivery. Patrons can request items [online](#) and call when they arrive at the scheduled time. A member of the library staff will delivery to the patron outside. Congregating and/or lingering outside the Library is also prohibited at this time. Drop-off of library items is still prohibited at this time and late fees are suspended until further notice. Online/virtual programs continue and Library users with questions are encouraged to contact the staff at: 207-377-8673.
