The Town Council hereby Resolves pursuant to Title 20-A, sections 2307, 1485 and 15690, that:

 The sum of <u>\$10,089,339.16</u> be appropriated for the total cost of funding public education from PK / kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act and the sum of <u>\$6,692,684.95</u> be raised as the Town's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15688;

2. The sum of **<u>\$0.00</u>** be raised and appropriated for the annual payments on debt service previously approved by the Town's voters for non-state-funded school construction projects and non-state-funded portions of school construction projects in addition to the funds appropriated as the local share of the Town's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12;

3. The School Committee be authorized to expend <u>\$11,782,350.36</u> for the fiscal year beginning <u>July 1, 2018</u> and ending <u>June 30, 2019</u> from the Town's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act, non-state-funded school construction projects, additional local funds for school purposes under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15690, unexpended balances, tuition receipts, state subsidy and other receipts for the support of schools;

The School Committee be authorized to expend such other sums as may be received from federal and state grants and/or programs and/or other sources during the fiscal year for school purposes provided that such grants, programs or other sources do not require the expenditures of other funds not previously appropriated; and
